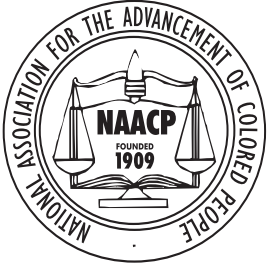

This form, the original signed credentials and all monies due must be mailed together. The advance registration order must be postmarked **no later than the August 31, 2009** (or by July 31, 2009 for the Early Bird Packages). **All additional registrations must be processed at an additional cost on-site.**

Section I: Contact Information

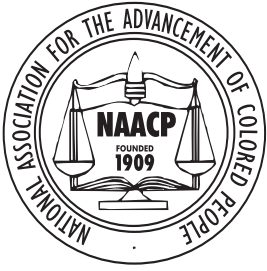
The Registering Person should be the person responsible for retrieving the Convention Package at Advance Registration. All information should be completed in this section. **Please note: Only the person listed as the Registering Person will be able to retrieve the packet.** Portions of packets **WILL NOT** be disbursed, nor will a different individual be allowed to retrieve a packet.

Section II: Package Orders (Two Delegates per package)

Only registrations that are postmarked by August 31, 2009 (or July 31, 2009 for Early Bird Package) are eligible for discounted packages. There are two packages being offered: **"EARLY BIRD" (BEST BUY - \$400 for Two Delegates)** WHICH MUST BE POSTMARKED BY July 31, 2009 and includes two full registrations; two Legislative Luncheon tickets; two Gala Awards Dinner tickets and full page Branch Ad; the **"LATE BIRD" (\$430 for two delegates)**, which includes two Legislative Luncheon tickets; two Gala Awards Dinner tickets and a full page Branch Ad. Write the total number of packages and the total cost of this section in the space provided. **Please note: When a registration package is selected, unless you need additional tickets, do not indicate any tickets in Section IV. Also, unless additional registrations are needed, do not indicate any information in Section III.**

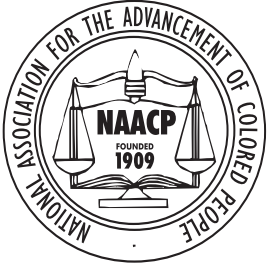
