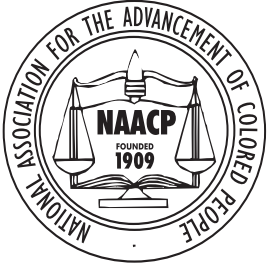

NJ NAACP 2009 Professional Development Workshops for Teachers

The New Jersey State Conference of the NAACP will again offer teachers two workshops and four (4) professional development hours at the 2009 Annual State Convention. The two professional development workshops will be held on Saturday, September 19, 2009 from 2:30 PM to 6:30 PM. America's oldest and largest civil rights organization will work with its community partners to empower teachers. One of the workshops will again be conducted by the New Jersey Amistad Commission, and another NAACP community partner will conduct the other workshop. Specific topics for the two workshops have not yet been determined.
